Consular services are strictly by appointment only:

Appointments can only be booked directly through our Appointment Booking System: <u>https://konzinfobooking.mfa.gov.hu/home</u>

- English can be selected as your language at the upper right corner.
- Please select Islamabad as your Customer Service.

$\circ\,$ One person may book one appointment and one case type at a time.

- The booking is to be made for the name of the applicant (not the proxy, sponsor, agent etc.)
 - Personal data given in the booking system and those shown in the currently valid passport must match exactly. Any differences in the personal details present in the filed passport, and of those given during booking will result in denial of application.
- All applicants are required to book their individual appointment for each of their cases, i.e. it is not allowed to book a single appointment for multiple applicants or for multiple cases.
 - The Consular Section may delete any irregular appointments without further notice.
- For C-type Schengen visas, applications may be submitted up to six months but at least 15 calendar days before the planned date of travel.
 - The Consular Section is not obliged to accept applications submitted less than 15 days before the planned date of travel. <u>Fast-tracking or expedited appointments and procedures are not available.</u>
- For D-type residence permit visas, applications may be submitted up to three months before the planned date of travel.
- \circ In case of an unannounced no-show, where the applicant does not cancel the appointment in time, any further appointments may be deleted without further notice.
- Three days before the booked appointment date, the applicant receives an automatic reminder in e-mail. Every applicant is required to respond to this reminder, confirming the appointment. If the applicant does not reply, The Embassy might cancel the appointment.
- For the purpose of security checks, and entry procedure, please <u>make sure that you arrive</u> <u>at least one hour prior to your booked appointment</u>. <u>Arriving late will result in denial of</u> <u>application</u>.
